Duties and Responsibilities of Recreation Counselor:

1. Teaches according to Center methods and ideology
2. Plans, organizes, and conducts activities in skill area.
3. Offers appropriate support to students through a positive attitude.
4. Maintains student instructional binders as activities are completed.
5. Addresses any programming concerns and offers suggested changes
6. Participates in all scheduled meetings
7. Performs administrative duties as assigned.
8. Maintains facilities, materials and class use.
